NEW ORDINANCES FOR PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

We have been busy with county and city planning ordinances that are going through review stages. Oregon Section AEG has provided input to Marion County who are also working with the City of Salem on geologic hazard planning ordinances. The City of Sandy is also in the draft stages of a planning ordinance that includes recognition of geologic hazards, and we are providing input to their committee. This type of AEG activity is one of the main reasons our association was created in the first place, to provide a recognized and collective voice to planning agencies.

FIELD TRIP

Our summer field trip has turned into a fall field trip, which is probably more appropriate because the subject has a tendency to occur in the fall and winter. We are going to be looking at and learning from some of the experts on debris flows or debris torrents. Our preliminary schedule includes discussions and watching video of the flume experiments with Dick Iverson, reviewing public policy with Keith Mills, and visiting three sites that include two recent flows and one that appears to be waiting to go.
